8–14 December VerseFirst x Beatitudes In August last year, our Instagram platform VerseFirst began a 5-month campaign to encourage people around the world to engage with the beatitudes, and to create content of their own using the nine "beats" from the NINE BEATS project, and featured in the Ninefold Path resource, as prompts. So far, VerseFirst has seen a rise in views and interactions, an increase in follower numbers, and engagement from new and existing followers who are embracing the call to creatively express their experience of the beatitudes.

Now, over this month of December, the focus is on the "way of radical love" – not only a fitting end to the campaign, but also a great way to mark Christmas and what the concept of radical love means in that context. "This initiative brings together VerseFirst, NINE BEATS and the Ninefold Path," says Elizabeth King who is heading up the campaign. "It's encouraging people to think about and engage with the messages of trust, lament, humility, justice, compassion, right motive, peacemaking, surrender, and radical love in a world being torn apart by war, hatred, and division."

Choose Life in Brazil

Choose Life is our curriculum for young people aged 9 to 14 years, that uses interactive lessons based on biblical values to help children identify choices and their consequences. "Through games and artwork, Choose Life helps children reflect about what is going on around them, enabling them to deal with the moral issues of life," says Cleisse Andrade from Lifewords in Brazil. "Issues like how to prevent and resolve conflicts, or how to relate to their local community. We look at matters such as honesty and integrity; prevention of drug use; HIV/AIDS and other aspects of safe sexual behaviour. Conscientious decisions, thoughtfully made, will help the children for the rest of their lives."

In Brazil, over 20 churches and social projects are using Choose Life with more than 620 children. Cleide Alabarce, from a Baptist church in Santa Cruz, Cascavel, in southern Brazil shared her experience of using Choose Life: "The majority of our children live in Mutirão, a very poor and violent place, close to our church. Some have parents and brothers in prison for different reasons: alcoholism, drugs, unemployment ... which leaves them very vulnerable. The church has fought to provide a more dignified life for each of them, using Choose Life. During the Choose Others module we realised that caring about others, and respecting and loving others and oneself, are seeds being planted in their lives, minds, and hearts. During classes and at the end of the module they showed more care and respect for their classmates."

Pray for the churches and projects using Choose Life, that they would have practical resources together with compassion and patience to work alongside the children, helping them make good choices for life.
